Martin Luther on "vocation":

Work is no longer simply a job or occupation; it is a calling, a vocation. It is a summons from God . . . in humble service to my neighbor . . On the surface, we see an ordinary human face — our mother, the doctor, the teacher, the waitress, our pastor — but, beneath the appearances, God is ministering to us through them, and to them through us.
