CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

P: Even though Your people Israel promised to obey You, O God, they quickly turned away from You. They followed their own hearts and desires. They worshipped other gods. We too have often done the same. We too have failed to always obey Your will. We too have failed to always live as You have called us to live. “For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.” (Ps 51:3)

C: Lord, I have sinned against You in thought, word, and action. Lord, have mercy on me.

- P: Against You, You only, have we sinned and done what is evil in Your sight. (Ps 51:4)
- C: **Lord, I have sinned against others in ways I know and in ways known only by You. Christ, have mercy on me.**
- P: All we like sheep have gone astray; we have all turned to our own way. (Is 53:6)
- C: **Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. (Ps 51:2)
Lord, have mercy on me.**
- P: The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, You will not despise. (Ps 51:17)
- C: **Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. (Ps 51:10)**

(silence for personal confession and self-reflection)

- P: We know that we are redeemed from our sinful ways not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but only with the precious blood of Jesus and His innocent suffering and death (1 Pet 1:18-19). In Christ we have redemption and the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sins. Therefore, I announce to you that you are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
